Quick Tutorial for reading a lead sheet.

Swedish Melody (1874)

Chords: D, A, Em, D

Chords: G, D, A7, D

If you're very new to the idea of a lead sheet, try playing only the root of the chord. It's easy to find because it's the name of the chord. This first example shows you the notes.

Chords: G, D, A7, D

This second example uses more of the chord notes, except in the A chord. The reason the top note is omitted in this case is to avoid the collision with the right hand which will need the same string very soon.
